11 **NEW SECTION. Sec. 1074. FOR THE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT**  
12 Catastrophic Flood Relief (20084850)

13 The appropriation in this section is subject to the following  
14 conditions and limitations:

15 (1) Up to \$26,800,000 of the appropriation is for advancing the  
16 long-term strategy for the Chehalis Basin projects to reduce flood  
17 damage and restore aquatic species including a programmatic  
18 environmental impact statement, data collection, engineering design  
19 of future construction projects, feasibility analysis, and engagement  
20 of state agencies, tribes, and other parties.

21 (2) Up to \$23,200,000 of the appropriation is for construction of  
22 local priority flood protection and habitat restoration projects.

23 (3) Up to one percent of the appropriation provided in this  
24 section may be used by the recreation and conservation office to  
25 administer contracts associated with the subprojects funded through  
26 this section. Contract administration includes, but is not limited to  
27 to: Drafting and amending contracts, reviewing and approving  
28 invoices, tracking expenditures, and performing field inspections to  
29 assess project status when conducting similar assessments related to  
30 other agency contracts in the same geographic area.
