Project description, including project phases:	It is proposed that a dike be designed and constructed along the west side of the Wishkah River within the city of Aberdeen corporate limits. Alternatives will be analyzed and selected to be incorporated into a public bid for construction. The total length of the project is approximately 2,800 feet terminating near the Wishkah Street and North Aberdeen bridges.
Scope of work showing timeline, expenditure plan and deliverables:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Preliminary Engineering 2. Alternative selection 3. Permitting 4. 100% bid package 5. Award bid 6. Construction and administration.
Description and timing of flood hazard reduction benefit(s) to be achieved:	The construction of a elevated roadway or dike by July 2015. Protecting structures subject to flooding bordering the west side including those not directly adjacent to the Wishkah River.
Plan to ensure project completion and full utilization of funds by 7/01/2015:	July 2015 presents a fairly tight time frame. Initial concepts were for a 24 month project timeframe. In order to meet the deadline we propose to utilize consultant selected through RFP for flood authority projects on the east side of the Wishkah River and or an adequate construction completion extension.
