I am wondering why my county elected officials who I have contacted directly have not provided the contacts you suggested, and I will make the effort to contact them and brief them.

I am sorry if I jumped the chain of command, but I will assure you that I know my stuff, and I have lived along this stretch of the wynoochee for over 35 years. I can see what is happening with the graphical data from the dam. The operation of the dam simply defies logic if I assume it is a flood control dam and being used to mitigate flooding. I am beginning to suspect that the dam has been used as a weapon to compel willing sellers. What I have collected is physical proof of the tabular data that the wynoochee dam is being opened at the peak of tributary inflow volumes. If you start at Big creek, you will see that the wynoochee dam is being released....from 240 CFS to 6000 CFS at peak inflow events, and you literally have a tidal wave. instead of mitigating floodwaters, the wynoochee dam is being used to deliberately make flooding worse,, Who do I call when a federal agency is misbehaving? Rep kilmer? sen patty murray?

I am an educated man, I am no fool, I have been blessed with a 20 year career with a fantastic law enforcement agency.

I live up the wynoochee, and we have a real issue on our hands that will turn into a nightmare if it is not addressed this year. In a nutshell, the river has eroded away an alder forest and the naturally occurring sediment berm on a curve in the river, and now during high water events the river is breaching its banks and entering a low lying old channel and Matt Rohr creek bed.
