In the Table of Contents in the list of Appendices, Appendix D says "Map: Regional growth centers and 40/20 Basins Near Flow Control Exempt Waters". Footnote 18 on Page 9 also says "See Attachment C . . . 40/20 Basins Near Flow Control Exempt Waters". The title on the map in Appendix C says "Regional Growth Centers . . . 40/20 Basins Near Flow Control Exempt Waters."

Should "40/20" be changed to "40% Impervious Cover since 1985" for consistency with maps published by Washington State Department of Ecology? If not, then can the document clarify what the "40/20" is referring to?

Also, it looks like "Attachment" is used in the document rather than "Appendix". Should a consistent term be used?
