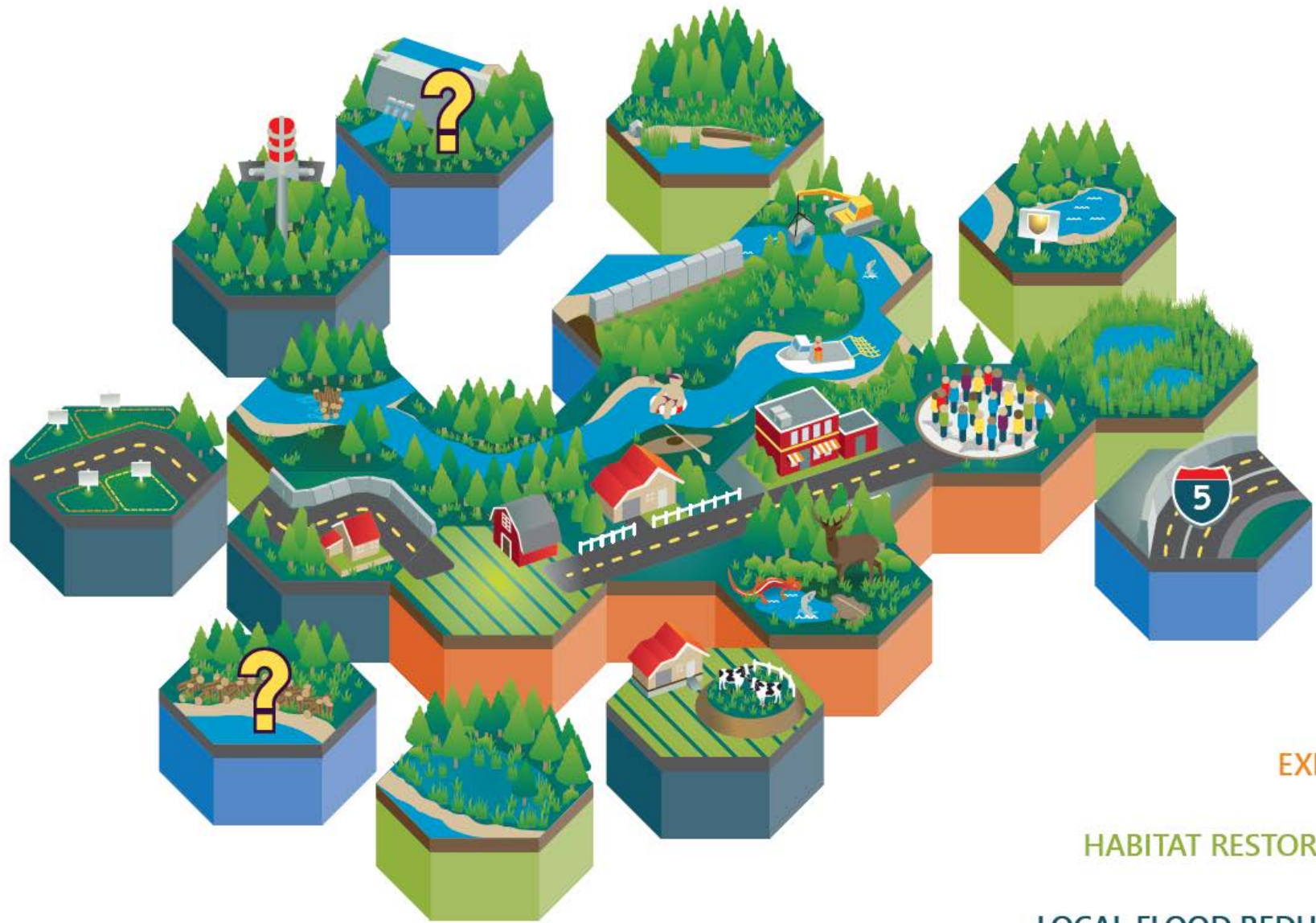
# Initial Observations
