Interim Actions

1. Technical support to communities
2. Technical assistance to landowners
3. Interim technical support and retrofit projects (targeted)
4. State-generated assessments and mapping

Spring 2020 Solicitation

Technical support for communities:

- Ongoing
- Inquiries fielded by Office of Chehalis Basin (OCB), addressed with appropriate technical advisor in coordination with requesting community.

Technical assistance for landowners:

- Advice (ongoing) - call or email
- Project development (Tier I received by August 30, 2020) - letter of interest
- Inquiries fielded by OCB. Landowners are connected to appropriate advisor.

Positioning for 2021 Implementation

1. Supported communities better positioned for future project funds
2. Assisted landowners have proposed projects for ranking, projects receiving funding can begin design & permitting
3. Framework tested through interim technical support and retrofit projects
4. Better understanding of channel migration/erosion risks and priorities
