Dear Jane:

On behalf of Grays Harbor Conservation District, Parametrix is pleased to submit the JARPA and required attachments needed for land use approval from Grays Harbor County for the Lower Satsop Right Bank Conservation Project. As you know from our early coordination meetings, the purpose of the project is to provide conservation of approximately 1,950 feet of riverbank and adjacent farmland along the lower Satsop River in order to reduce current aggressive rates of erosion, conserve the right bank line, and generally preserve the river's migration corridor until the Lower Satsop Restoration and Protection Program's Phase II project is constructed (summer 2022). In order for the project to be constructed prior to winter and to minimize future bank loss, the project must be constructed this fall. We understand that meeting permit review timelines will be a challenge, especially for the shoreline review process. We appreciate your assistance in expediting the review process to the extent practicable.

The following JARPA and attachments serves as the application for the following land use permits required by the County: Shoreline, fish and wildlife conservation critical areas, floodplain, and SEPA review.
