Project Funding

- \$450K increase in Capital Budget
- \$450K match from OCB
- Currently determining most efficient funding flow (mechanics, timing, options, etc.).

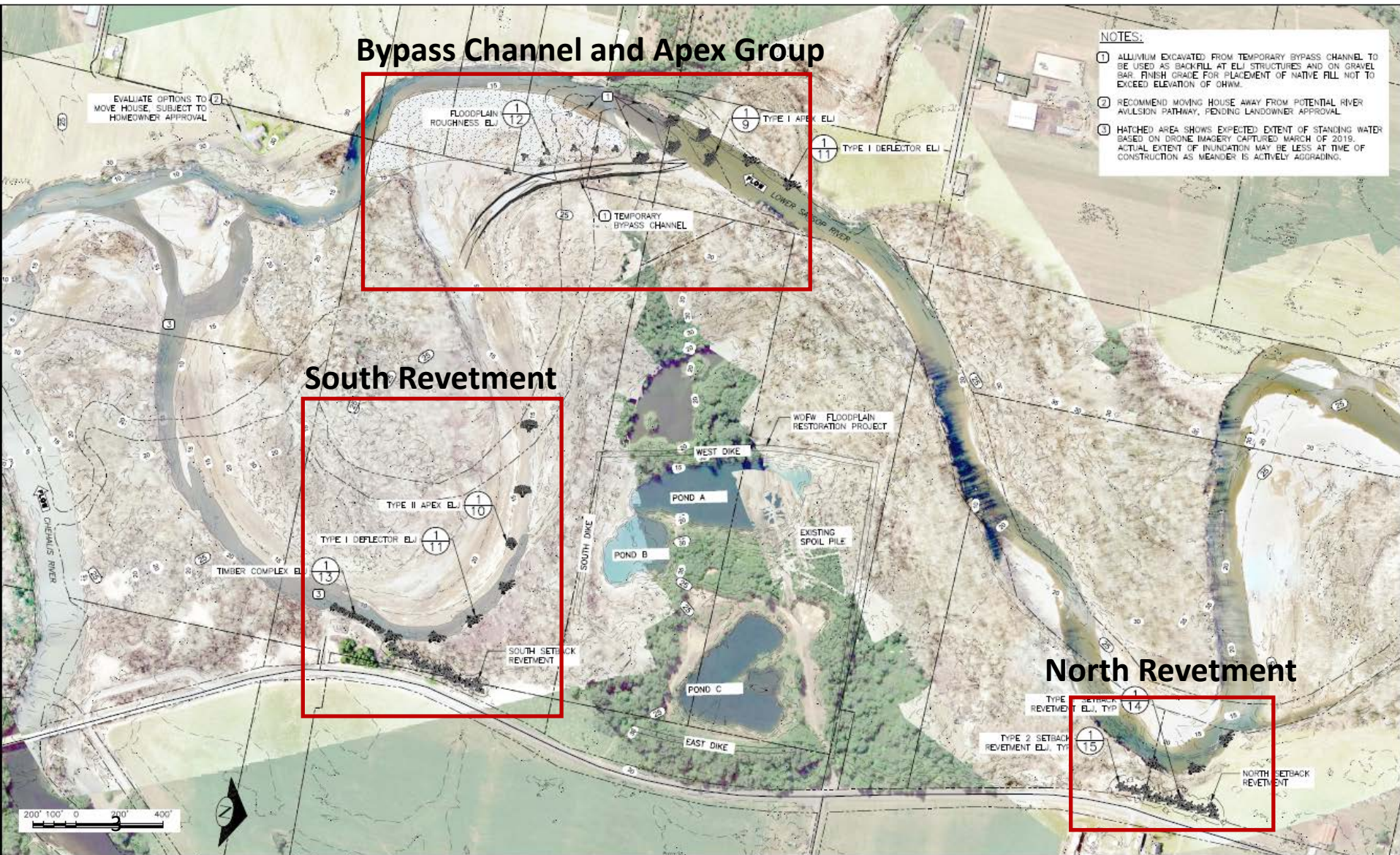

8 alternative transportation networks, and lost timber production
9 associated with the project.

10 (2)(a) Up to ((\$49,450,000)) \$49,900,000 of the appropriation is
11 for construction of local priority flood protection and habitat
12 restoration projects.

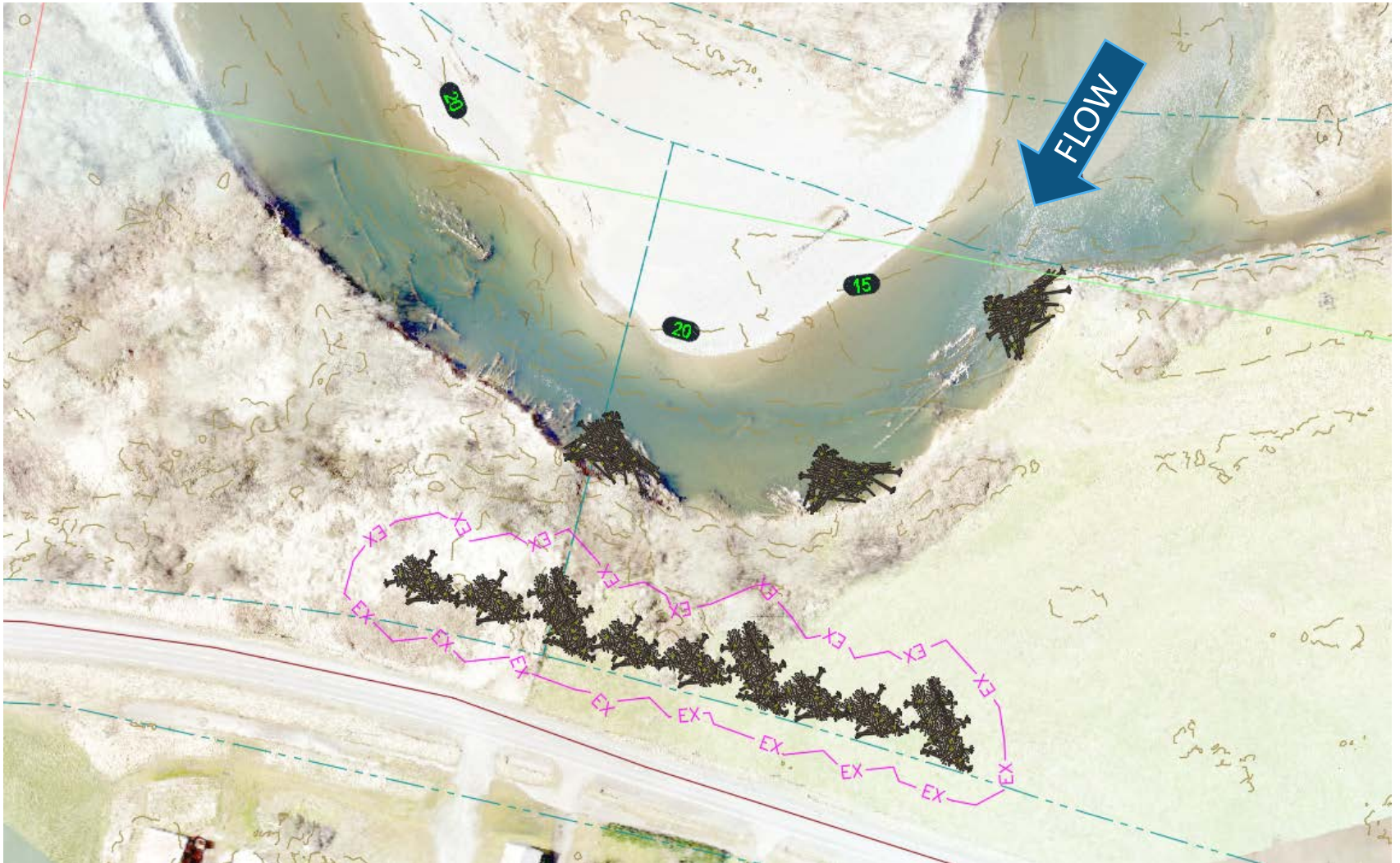
13 (b) Of the amount provided in this subsection, up to \$450,000 is
14 for a state match for equal funding from the office of the Chehalis
15 basin for the Lower Satsop Restoration and Protection Program Keys
16 Road Protection Project.

JARPA Overview – NWP 13 Bank Stabilization

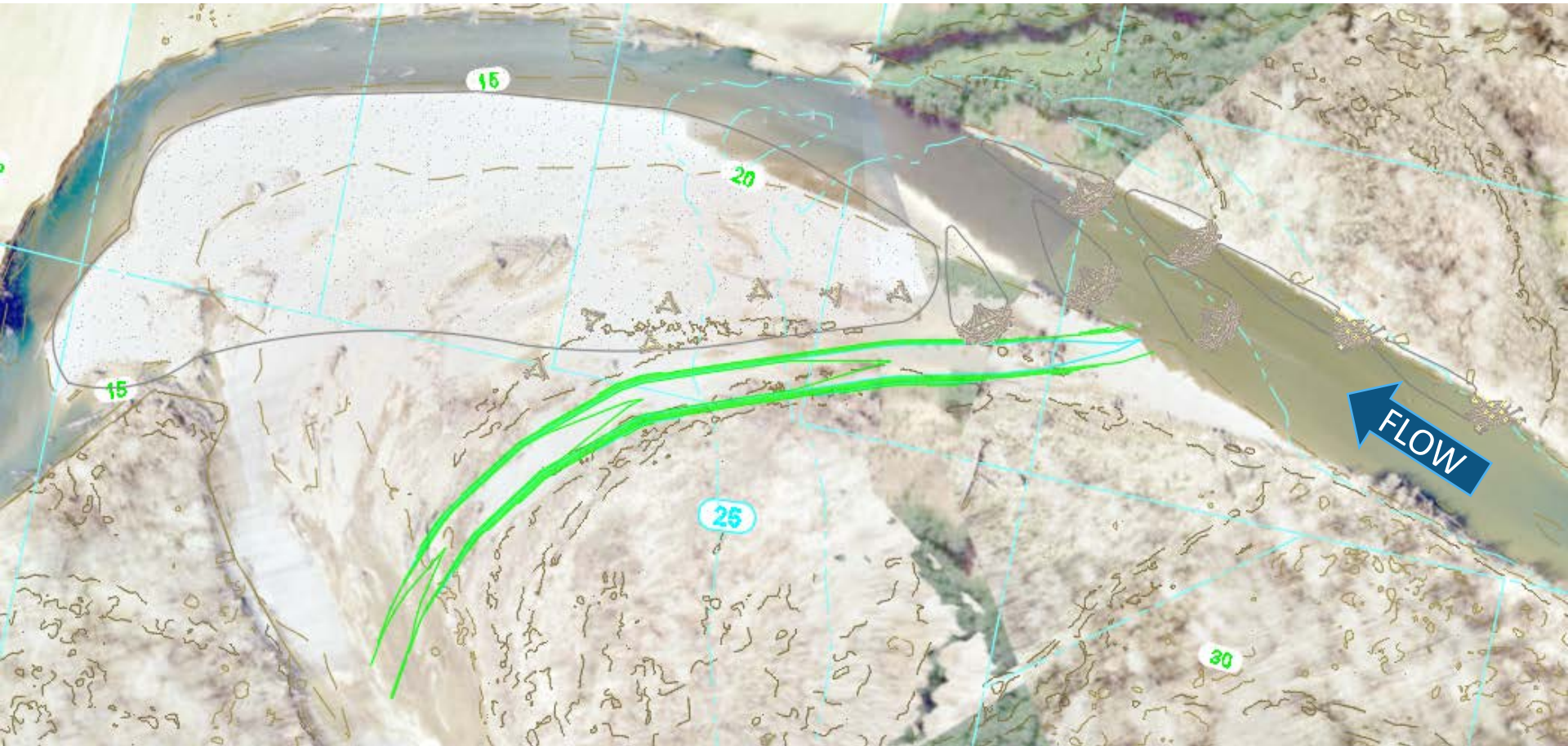
- **Cultural Resources:** Not anticipated to encounter archaeological sites or expected to affect any NRHP-eligible historic properties.
- **Abbreviated BE**
 - ▶ Bull Trout, Marbled Murrelet, Streaked Horned-Lark, Yellow Billed Cuckoo: May Affect, Not Likely to Adversely Affect
 - ▶ Fisher: No effect
- **Wetlands and Critical Areas:** Temporary impacts to 0.33 acres of wetland.
- **Flood Impacts:** Local improvements in floodplain connectivity. No impacts to flood conveyance or inundation extent at reach scale.



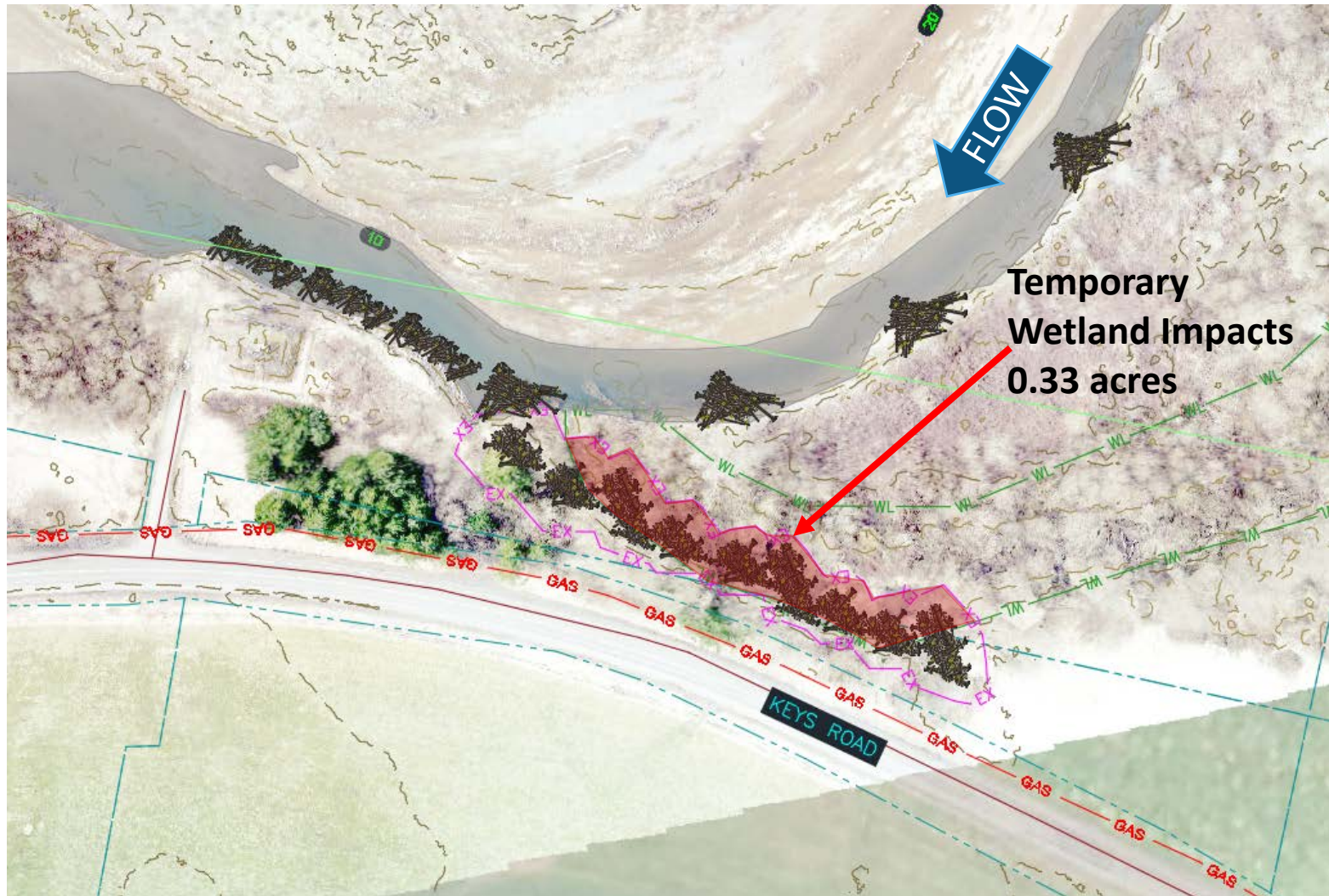
North Setback Revetment

Construction Timeline

- Permitting may affect timeline
- Put out to bid by mid-May
- Construction to begin mid-July
- In-water work window August 1 -31
- Setback Revetment could be constructed outside of fish window
- Will require close coordination with WDFW as they finish Phase II of their Lower Satsop Floodplain Restoration Project.

2021 Reach Scale Design

- Have applied for \$1.8M in grant funding to support reach-scale design and construction
 - ▶ 2020 – 2021 ASRP
 - ▶ 2021 – 2022 WCRRI
- Goal is to (a) build on investment in East Fork Satsop by improving connectivity between critical habitats and (b) achieve reach-scale effect on sediment dynamics.
 - ▶ 35 in-channel structures
 - ▶ 130 acres of riparian planting
 - ▶ 10 acres of invasive species treatment
- Chehalis River Basin Flood Authority will be issuing (mid-May) a request for 2021-23 local project proposals. This could be potential funding source to understand and address erosion issues facing Monte-Elma Bridge.
