

The Permit Timeliness Report is in response to a [State Auditor's Performance Audit](#) and [RCW 43.42A](#). Each regulatory agency considers the customer experience to ensure permit assistance is simple to use, easy to access, and designed in a customer-friendly manner. Each agency aims to improve permit clarity, predictability, and timeliness. Agencies report the progress to the Governor's Office for Regulatory Innovation and Assistance (ORIA) who then prepares and distributes the report with participation from the State Auditor's Office and Results Washington.

Fourteen Washington State agencies report on permit timeliness:

Major Permit Timeliness milestones include:

-  **Agency Permitting Plans** *(Complete: June 30, 2014)*
Agencies directed their websites to ORIA's website to streamline the customer's experience. Agencies collected and provided data to ORIA. This includes a list of permits, permit assistance available, how to access permit assistance, and other tools to help applicants successfully complete a permit application.
-  **Agency Progress Reports** *(Complete: June 30, 2015)*
Agencies sent their permit information to ORIA for the progress report. The progress report was the first step to provide customers with processing times, tools available to help with permit assistance, identify permits for improvement efforts, and application and decision making processing times.
-  **First and Second Comprehensive Progress Report** *(Complete: December 31, 2015, and September 30, 2016)*
-  **Agencies report updates to ORIA** *(Completed: March 1 and ongoing annually with no sunset date)*
ORIA collects performance data – permit application and decision making processing times. ORIA publishes the data in a central location. You can access the data from <https://data.wa.gov/>.
-  **Subsequent Comprehensive Progress Reports** *(September 30, 2018, and 2020)*
The report demonstrates improved clarity, predictability, and timeliness of permitting. They identified the permits available for data collection, application and decision making processing time, and permits targeted for improvement efforts. Agencies share successes from their improvement efforts. ORIA delivers the report to the Governor and economic development committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate.
