**SUBJECT:** 2025-27 Local Projects Recruitment Update

## 2025-2027 Local Projects Recruitment

- 1. Recruitment for 2025-27 Local Projects resulted in the evaluation of nine initial proposed projects, with a total of approximately \$17 million in requested projects funds.
- 2. Subsequent to original due date for consideration (May 10, 2024), three additional projects were added as second-order projects for a cost of \$521,750 (i.e., they would be considered for funding after first considering those submitted on-time by the original due date).
  - Chehalis -- WWTP Phase II (Permitting) -- Planning is under way to demolish the derelict WWTP, however funding is needed to develop permits (\$200,000).
  - Lewis County -- Dillenbaugh Gages -- Funding would support the installation of one rain gage and one stream gage in the Dillenbaugh watershed to help the City of Chehalis and Port of Chehalis with their flood strategy and investment plan (\$70,000).
  - Chehalis Coal Creek Feasibility and Design -- Funding would cover 50 percent of task 1 through task 5, including a feasibility assessment, community engagement, Ecology QAPP, legal review and alternatives analysis (\$251,750).
- 3. Additionally, Flood Authority staffing costs have increased for the biennium, and grant administration costs have decreased (No RCO 1.5% for 2025-27).
- 4. After refining project work and the feasibility of completing projects tasks within the 2025-27 funding cycle, the total cost was refined to \$13,101,000 (high-cost estimate).
- 5. Below is a summary of proposed projects recommended for funding and the distribution of requested funding.
