SUBJECT: Executive Committee action

The following Executive Committee action will be discussed at Thursday's Flood Authority meeting. Please feel free to contact me with questions (360/480-6600, <u>scottb@sbgh-partners.com</u>).

I. <u>Background</u>

- a. Lewis County is fiscal agent to the Flood Authority.
- b. As fiscal agent, Lewis County enters into funding agreements with RCO (Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office) on behalf of the Flood Authority in order to implement Flood Authority activities and priorities.
- c. In September 2022, Lewis County received a funding amendment from RCO to add \$110,000 to install a new gage on China Creek and to update the Flood Authority's 2017 Basin Gage Plan.
- d. In order for Lewis County to sign RCO's September funding amendment, Lewis County needed affirming direction from the Flood Authority that this is what the Flood Authority wanted Lewis County to do (i.e., sign the RCO funding amendment to add \$110,000).

II. 10/08/2022 and 10/11/2022 Executive Committee Action

- a. The Flood Authority Executive Committee took action on 10/08/2022 and 10/11/2022 (via email) to approve a staff recommendation that Lewis County be authorized to sign the RCO funding amendment to add \$110,000 to install a new gage on China Creek and update the Flood Authority's 2017 Basin Gage Plan.

The following is for discussion as an Executive Committee meeting. - 1. Lewis County is fiscal agent to the Flood Authority. On behalf of the Flood Authority Lewis County prepares scopes of work, authorizes contracts and personal services agreements, signs funding agreements and funding amendment, and more.
- 2. In September 2022, Lewis County received a funding amendment from RCO to add \$110,000 to install a new gage on China Creek and update the Flood Authority's 2017 Basin Gage Plan. In order for Lewis County to sign this amendment, Lewis County needs affirming direction from the Flood Authority that this is what the Flood Authority would like Lewis County to do (i.e., sign the RCO funding amendment to add \$110,000).

I. <u>Background</u>

1. Install New China Creek Gage -- \$35,000

- At the July 7, 2022 Chehalis Basin Board meeting the Board approved (pg. 3, row 5, here) a Flood Authority funding request for \$35,000 to install a new Flood Warning System stream gage on China Creek as described <u>here</u> (pg. 37). The Flood Authority previously discussed this at their March 2022 meeting (<u>here</u>), May 2022 meeting (<u>here</u>), and July 2022 meeting (<u>here</u>).
- This work is underway.

2. Update 2017 Basin Gage Plan -- \$75,000

• At the July 7, 2022 Chehalis Basin Board meeting the Board approved (pg. 3, row 11, <u>here</u>) a Flood Authority funding request for \$75,000 to update the Flood Authority's <u>2017 Gage Master</u>

<u>Plan</u> as described <u>here</u> (pg. 6, row 11). The Flood Authority previously discussed this at their March 2022 meeting (<u>here</u>), May 2022 meeting (<u>here</u>), and July 2022 meeting (<u>here</u>).

3. Relocate Webcam from Lower Satsop to Aberdeen -- \$3,952.35

- At the May 19, 2022 Flood Authority meeting, the Flood Authority approved (8.C, <u>here</u>) Lewis County transferring \$3,952.35 in available Lewis County Flood Authority fiscal agent staff funds to WEST Consultants to cover WEST's costs of relocating the Flood Authority's Lower Satsop webcam from Chapman Farms to the city of Aberdeen's sewer pump station overlooking the Wishkah river and bridge.
- This work has been completed (<u>here</u>).

II. <u>Staff Recommendation/Executive Committee Action</u>

Staff recommends the Executive Committee authorize Lewis County as fiscal agent for the Flood Authority to take the following actions:

- **Install New China Creek Gage** -- Sign any amendments and/or agreements necessary to implement this action including amendments and/or agreements with RCO and WEST Consultants.
- **Update 2017 Basin Gage Plan** -- Sign any amendments and/or agreements necessary to implement this action including amendments and/or agreements with RCO and WEST Consultants.
- **Relocate Webcam from Lower Satsop to Aberdeen** Amend WEST Consultants' personal services agreement with Lewis County to implement this action.
