SUBJECT: Future Projects

- 1. More than 100 local flood hazard reduction projects have been completed across the Chehalis Basin since the 2007 and 2009 floods, many coordinated and funded through the Office of Chehalis Basin.
- 2. Flood Authority's Projects Committee met 09/12/2023 and discussed future local projects beyond 2025.
- 3. Projects Committee discussed taking a deliberate, structured look across the Basin to identify future local projects that can be assembled into a master local projects capital funding list** for consideration as part of the larger long-term strategy under development by the Chehalis Basin Board.
