SUBJECT: Outreach Updates

The purpose of this memo is to provide Flood Authority members with an update on current Outreach & Education Committee next steps. We will review and discuss this proposal on tomorrow's 5-18-2017 Flood Authority conference call. A. Background

- 1. The Flood Authority has had an Outreach & Education Committee since 2011.
- The Outreach & Education Committee has played a valuable role in helping to create a presence and identify for the Flood Authority and its actions and activities.
- 3. Outreach & Education efforts overtime have been more active in some years than in other years.
- 4. With the ten-year anniversary of the December 2007 flood soon approaching, Flood Authority staff (Scott Boettcher) and Outreach & Education Committee Chair (Dan Wood) met and discussed outreach and education opportunities.
- 5. In general, it was agreed the timing is ripe for a thoughtful, opportunistic outreach and education focus for the Flood Authority given the upcoming ten-year anniversary of the December 2007 event.
- 6. In addition to the usual of pamphlets, presentations, one-pagers, fairs, etc., it was agreed that collecting and connecting with personal stories would be very valuable as well documenting how much better prepared the basin is for a major flood than it was in 2007. It was further agreed that figuring out how to do so was best a topic for the full Outreach & Education Committee and as such the Committee should soon convene.

B. Next Steps

The following next steps have been identified to occur before the next Flood Authority meeting:

- Convene Outreach & Education Committee in late-May, early-June to discuss and scope out next steps related to:

 - b. Participating in 2017 Southwest Washington Fair (8/15-20/2017) -- http://southwestwashingtonfair.net/
 - c. Initiating a ten-year anniversary "recognition/acknowledgement" (December 2007 to December 2017)
 - d. Developing a prioritized list of outreach and education priorities.
 - e. Coordinating with others doing outreach and education in the Basin.
 - f. Collecting and connecting with personal stories.
 - g. Implementing Flood Authority website improvements (to aid and support entrance of new Office of Chehalis Basin as well clarify distinct role and function of the Flood Authority).
- 2. Report back at the June 15, 2017 Flood Authority meeting.
