SUBJECT: Amendment to Lewis County/RCO Agreement Re French and Associates

The purpose of this memo is to provide Flood Authority members with a recommendation on authorizing a \$60,000 increase in Lewis County's Chehalis River Basin Flood Authority contract with RCO to further support work across the Basin on local flood proofing as described below. We will review and discuss this proposal on tomorrow's 3-16-2017 Flood Authority conference call. A. Background

French and Associates has been under contract to Lewis County to provide "Local Flood Proofing" support and technical assistance to the Flood Authority and its member jurisdictions across the Basin.

In light of increasing interest for French and Associates services from local communities and local interests in the Basin, and budget increase is needed as follows:

- French and Associates Contract Provision Task 1.2: Work with the Department of Ecology to develop a floodproofing strategy for the next biennium. This will include drafting the community participation criteria and standards for an inventory of flood prone buildings in the Basin.
- French and Associates Contract Provisions Tasks 3.1. and 3.2: Assist Aberdeen, Hoquiam, and Grays Harbor County apply to join the Community Rating System.
- French and Associates Contract Provision Task 3.3: Provide guidance and support to Basin communities on administering the recommended improved floodplain management regulatory standards.
- French and Associates Contract Provision Task 3.5: Assist Chehalis with the latest changes in the Community Rating System and prepare for its five-year verification visit in Fall 2017.

B. Recommended Next Steps

The Flood Authority recommends authorizing the additional local flood proofing work as described at a cost of \$60,000 as follows:

- 1. Lewis County first approve the attached RCO prepared \$60,000 cost increase to Lewis County's overall budget.
- 2. Lewis County prepare and then execute a \$60,000 cost increase with French and Associates to accomplish the above described work.

- 4) Secure necessary technical expertise to advise the Flood Authority and participating Basin communities on retrofitting buildings to meet flood opening criteria requirements, preparing local area analyses to identify candidates for future building elevation projects, and improving local floodplain management programs.
