A brief summary of the projects I mentioned for inclusion on the list you are compiling.

* Problems-Citizens of the Wishkah community are often isolated during flood events. Solution-Assess and evaluate alternative solutions to address flooding between MP 1 and MP 5. This might include construction or preservation of water retention facilities (natural or constructed) and elevate critical infrastructure. Source: GHC Draft Hazard Mitigation Plan 2011

* Problem-Chronic flooding isolated community members and damages public infrastructure. Solution-Reduce flood velocity by widening the conveyance (stream channel) at MP 8.2 of the South Bank Road. Source: GHC Draft Hazard Mitigation Plan 2011 This site is just one of over 2500+ inventoried culverts throughout the Chehalis Basin by Lewis and Mason Conservation Districts.
