- Best way to get people to notice your page is to go out and find the business owners, like their page, like or comment on their pictures or posts.
- You can start posting things on your page to gain interest by others but as for advertising these, your best bet would be to start interacting with businesses on your page.
- Make sure the content on your page is valuable to your target audience.
- You are able to do random searches through Facebook just like in Google.
- As for records, Facebook date and time stamps comments. You would want to work with your agency to figure out what would work best for records retention. You could very well print screen and keep it as a record if needed.
- If you want you can do live feed, videos and answer questions on the spot.
