The Chehalis Basin Board is tied to the Office of Chehalis Basin, created within the state Department of Ecology by the 2016 Washington Legislature.

Lawmakers tasked the board with developing a long-term strategy to reduce flood damages and restore aquatic species habitat in the Chehalis River drainage basin, and developing budget recommendations to the Governor.

The Office of Chehalis Basin is responsible for working with the board and administering funding for flood damage reduction, aquatic habitat restoration and related projects. The office was established within Ecology on July 1, 2017.
