2-3 pilot projects, plus a technical program development workgroup



TIMELINE AND KEY PLAYERS

Grays Harbor CD to sponsor project

WDFW is issuing permits

Flood Authority and OCB coordinating and funding agencies

Emergency Permit Issued | Contracts Signed | Construction Begins | Restoration Construction1-3 Weeks|2-3 Weeks|3-4 Weeks|Next Year



FUNDING

\$ ~15K - Homeowner

\$ 75K – OCB Erosion Management Program

\$109K – Redirected funds from this Fall's GHCD Lower Satsop Right Bank Conservation Project

Total of \$184k of Strategy funding



QUESTIONS TO BE ANSWERED

The Flood Authority requests that this pilot project answer the following questions?

- What has been the rate of channel erosion?
- How long has erosion been a concern in this area?
- Did the current homeowner receive any disclosures about the erosion?
- What were the creek and 100-year floodplain boundaries in 2002 when the septic system was installed?
- Are there any "lessons-learned" to be had?
