- The Erosion Management Program funding of \$895,000 is fully allocated for this biennium.
- 2 urgent/imminent projects, 1 reach-scale project, and 1 technical advancement project will be completed.
- OCB staff see high demand for this integrated program.

Program Fully Funded

The Board approved \$895,000 in erosion management program funding in the 23-25 biennium. Those funds were split between \$500,000 for urgent/imminent projects, \$285,000 for reach-scale projects, \$80k for program support, and \$30,000 for technical advancement.

Four Total Projects

The Lewis and Grays Harbor Conservation Districts have each been awarded an urgent imminent project, one on the Newaukum and one on the Wynoochee; the Grays Harbor CD has been awarded the one reach-scale project, on the lower Chehalis; and Anchor QEA will complete an erosion reduction design manual as a technical advancement project.

High Demand

Conservation Districts are reporting that there is high demand for the erosion management program.

Staff will support Board decision making about funding the Erosion Management Program in the 23-25 budget.
