

1953 (SW trajectory)




2019 (SE trajectory)





Recent Erosion Areas





2. Current Issue – December 28, 2020 Flood Event



2. Current Issue – Geomorphic Context

- Meander belt is moving west.
- Erosion hazard zone includes lands not occupied by the river in thousand years or more.



2. Current Issue – Soils Offer No Resistance



3. Request – Funding to Address Crisis Erosion

- **1. Flood Authority** approved de-obligating \$425,000 in 2019-21 funds from two local projects (and re-obligating later with 2021-23 funds) for an emergency action to address current crisis erosion. See here.
- **2. Proposal** is for a new GHCD/RCO funding agreement (project 20-????) to provide additional capacity to design, permit, and construct an emergency action (6/2021 to 10/2021).
- **3. Acting now** will: Buy time before Phase II construction (2022); Hold things in place for Phase II; and Prevent (hopefully) further erosion and flanking.

4. CBB decision – Per agenda:

- Re-allocate an initial \$100,000 of 2019-2021 local project funds for new emergency erosion management design and permitting work in vicinity of ongoing Lower Satsop Phase I/II projects.
- Conditionally re-allocate an additional \$325,000 of 2019-2021 local project funds for construction, if design and permitting allow.
- Increase 2021-2023 local projects funding by \$425,000 to replenish funding for projects from which the re-obligated (de-obligated) 2019-2021 funding will be taken.
