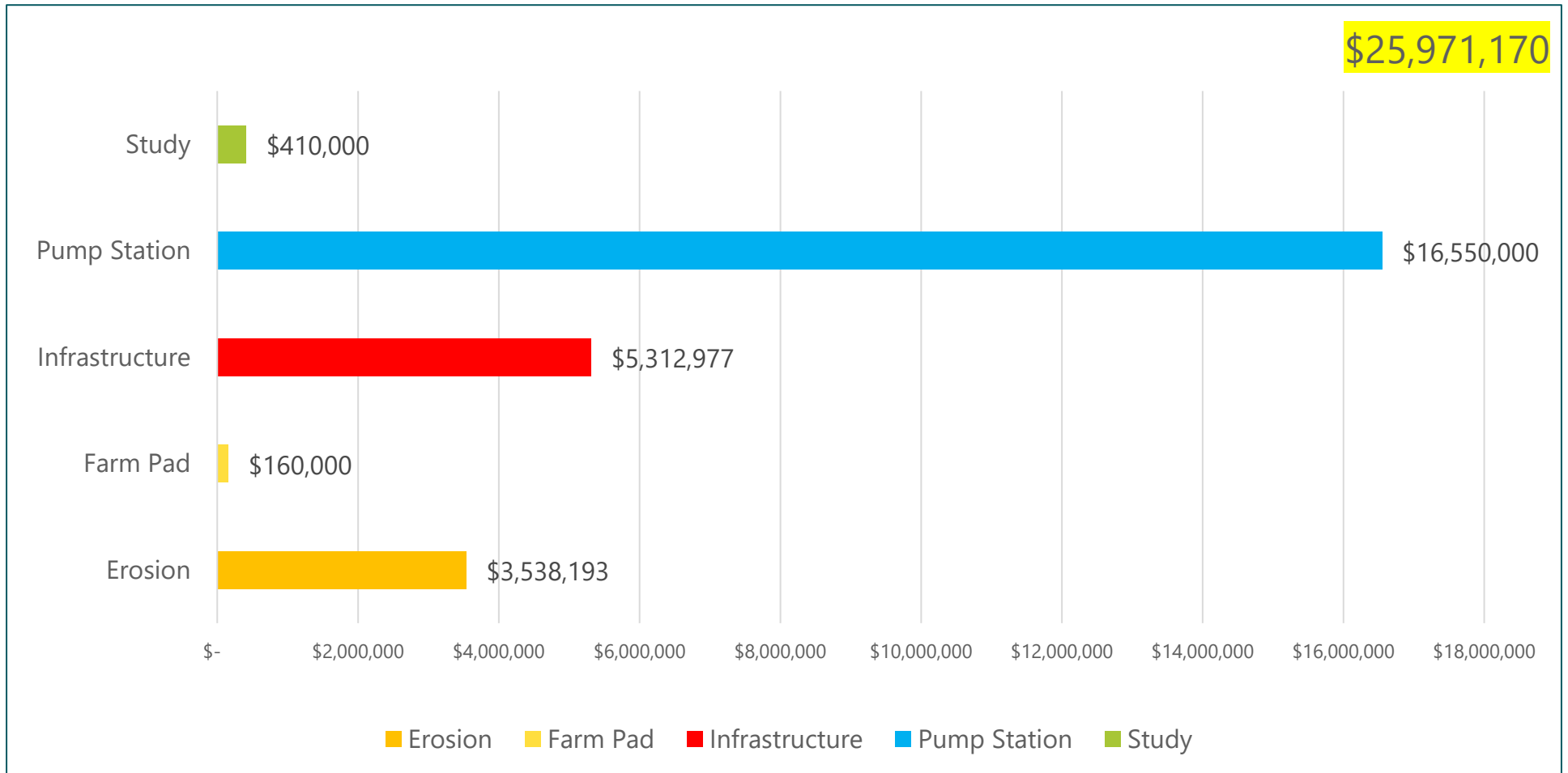
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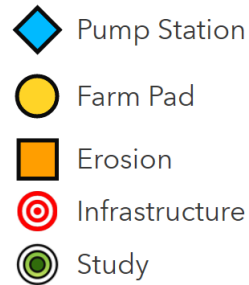

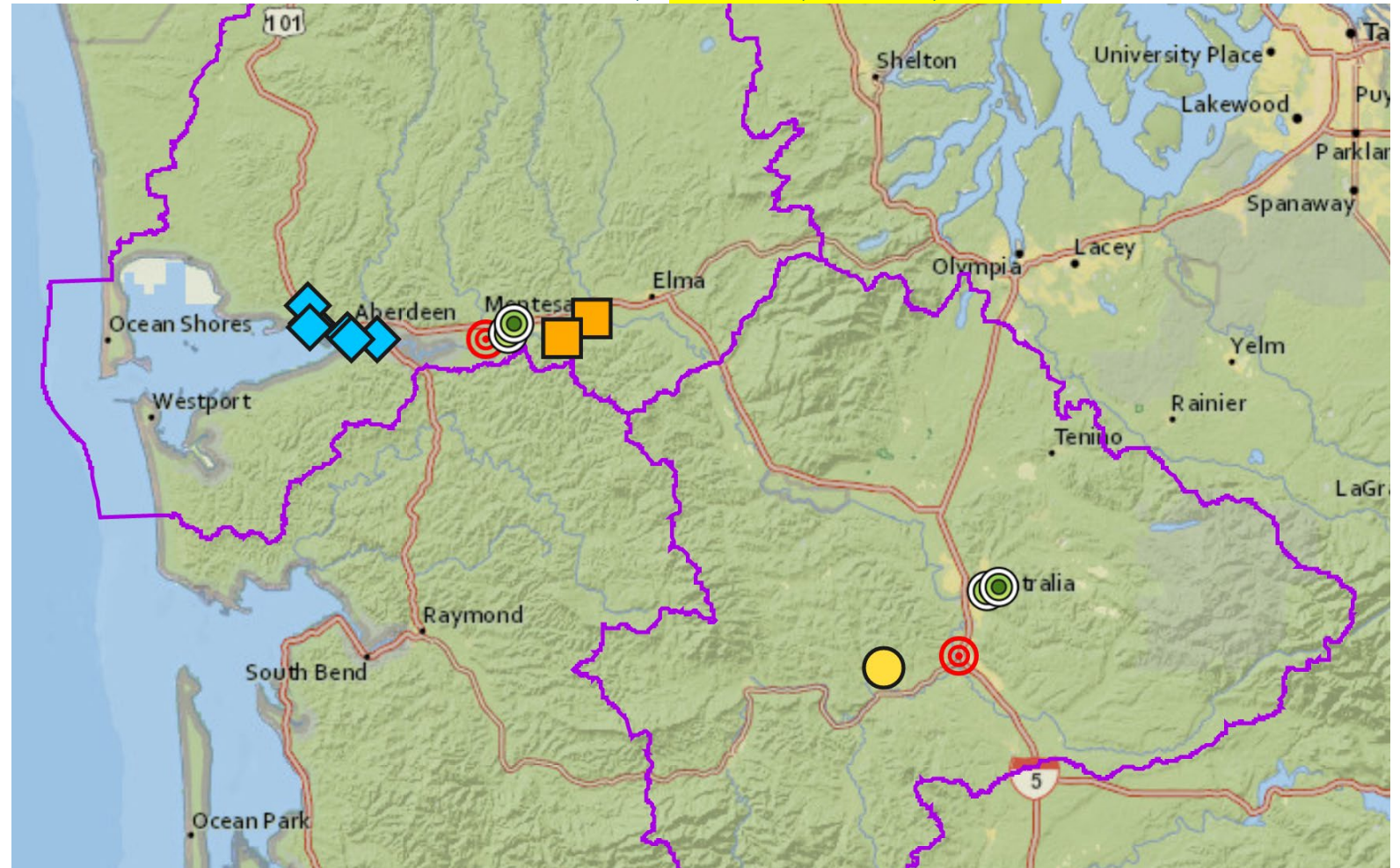
15 PROPOSALS RECEIVED, 5 PROJECT TYPES



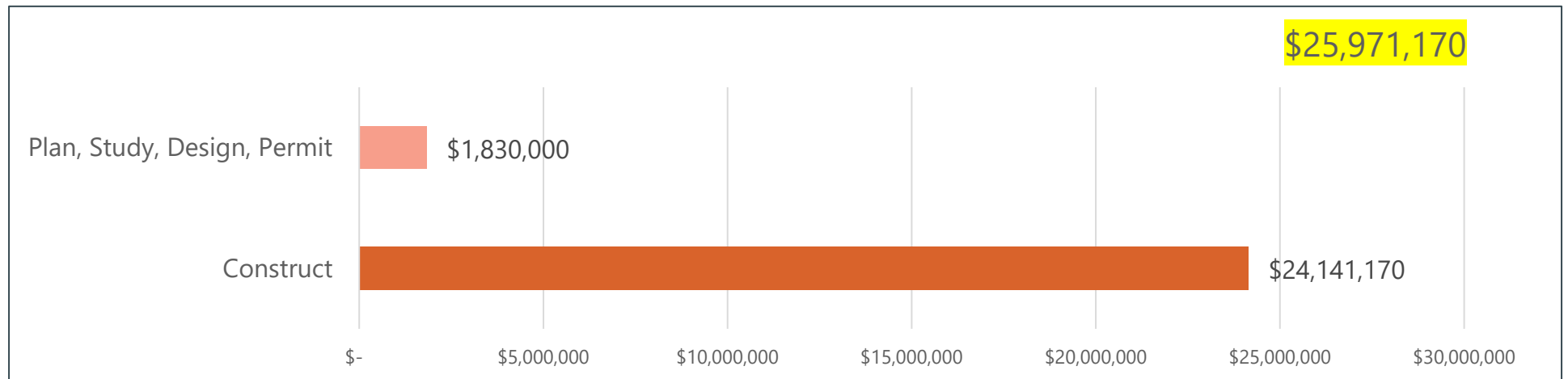
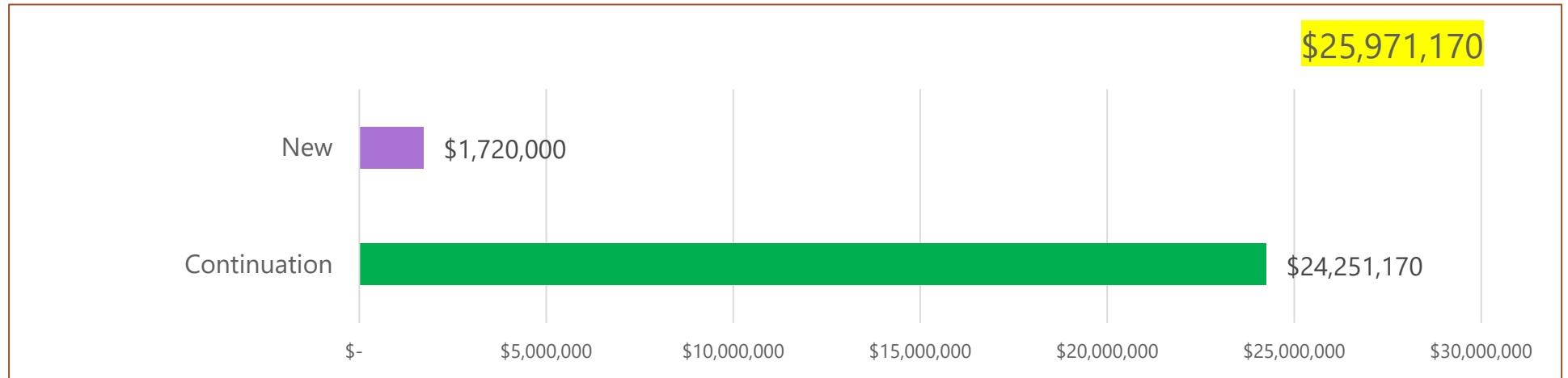

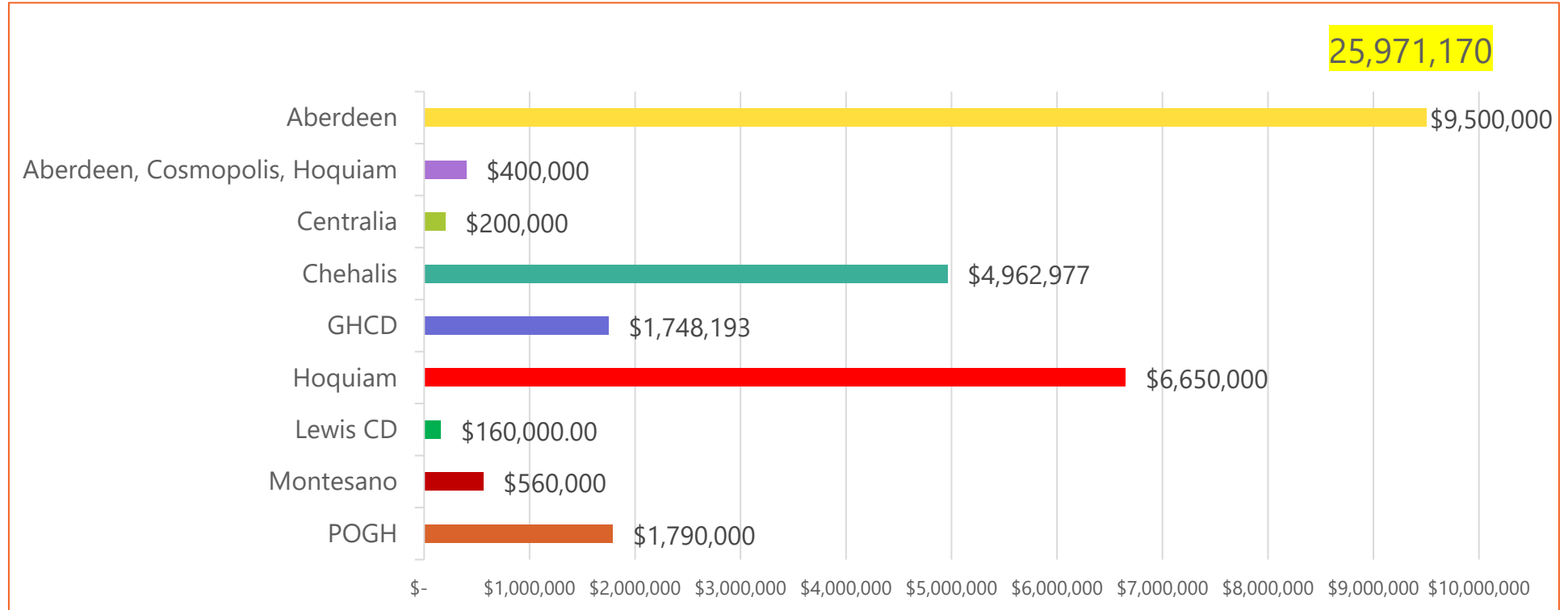

 - ✓ for the most
 - ✓ with the least cost
 - ✓ with the greatest ROI
5. Early cultural/archaeological screening.
