





Chemical Action Plan (CAP)

Persistent Bioaccumulative Toxic (PBT) Rule

- Identifies, characterizes, and evaluates uses and releases of a PBT, and recommends actions to protect human health and the environment.
- Chapter 173-333 Washington Administrative Code.

WAC 173-333-430: Process to develop CAPs

- Plan and collect information (2016/17)
- Work with advisory committee (2017)
- Review and collect more information (2017/18)
- Publish Interim CAP (April 2018)
- Comments on Interim CAP (May 2018)
- Draft recommendations Advisory Committee meeting (2018)
- Cost analysis webinar (2019)
- Publish Draft CAP (2019)
- Public comment/meeting (2019)
- Publish Final CAP (2019)
- Implement actions (ongoing)

Interim CAP Recommendations

Drinking Water:

- Support drinking water rulemaking.
- Drinking water testing.
- Technical assistance.

Environmental contamination:

- Develop cleanup levels soil, groundwater, surface water.
- Investigate effective cleanup methods.

Firefighting Foam:

- Implement firefighting foam restrictions (ESSB6413).
- Survey and outreach to foam users.
- · Replace PFAS foam.

Investigate Sources:

- Other sources of exposure.
- Firefighting PPE notification.
- Alternatives assessments, food packaging (ESHB2658).

PBT Recommendations

WAC 173-333-420:

- Reduce and phase-out uses and releases.
- Manage chemicals, products or wastes.
- Minimize exposure to the PBTs.
- Switch to safer alternatives.
- Encourage development of safer alternatives.



PFAS Concerns

Area of Concern	Problems or Issues
Alternatives assessments	Need more information on safer alternatives
Analytical methods	Few qualified labs, need approved methods for products, soil, biosolids, more analytes
Disposal	PFAS in products in the landfill, dangerous waste disposal
Ecosystem	Fish consumption advisories, impact on ecosystem and wildlife
Firefighting foam	Historic use, potential hot-spots, ferries, buildings with sprinkler systems, aircraft hangars, proper disposal, BMPs, alternatives assessment, cleanup resources
Health	More studies, more data, info about more PFAS, short versus long chain
Outreach	Convey PFAS info, risk reduction, CAP recommendations
Products	Info on products using PFAS, sales in WA, biggest sources of exposure, source for urban lakes
Remediation	Drinking water filters, groundwater remediation
Sources in WA	Refineries, metal plating, semiconductors, textiles, food contact materials, cosmetics, lubricants, car waxes, ski waxes, floor waxes, polishes, upholstery, leather
State action	Ban long chain, funding for cleanup actions

- Ecology/Health continue with Interim actions.
- Advisory Committee meets in October to discuss recommendations.
 - Cost analysis webinar in March 2019.
- Publish Draft CAP in Spring 2019.
 - 90-day comment period and public meetings.
- Review comments, discuss with Advisory Committee.
 - October 2019 Advisory Committee meeting.
- Publish Final CAP (Dec 2019).




