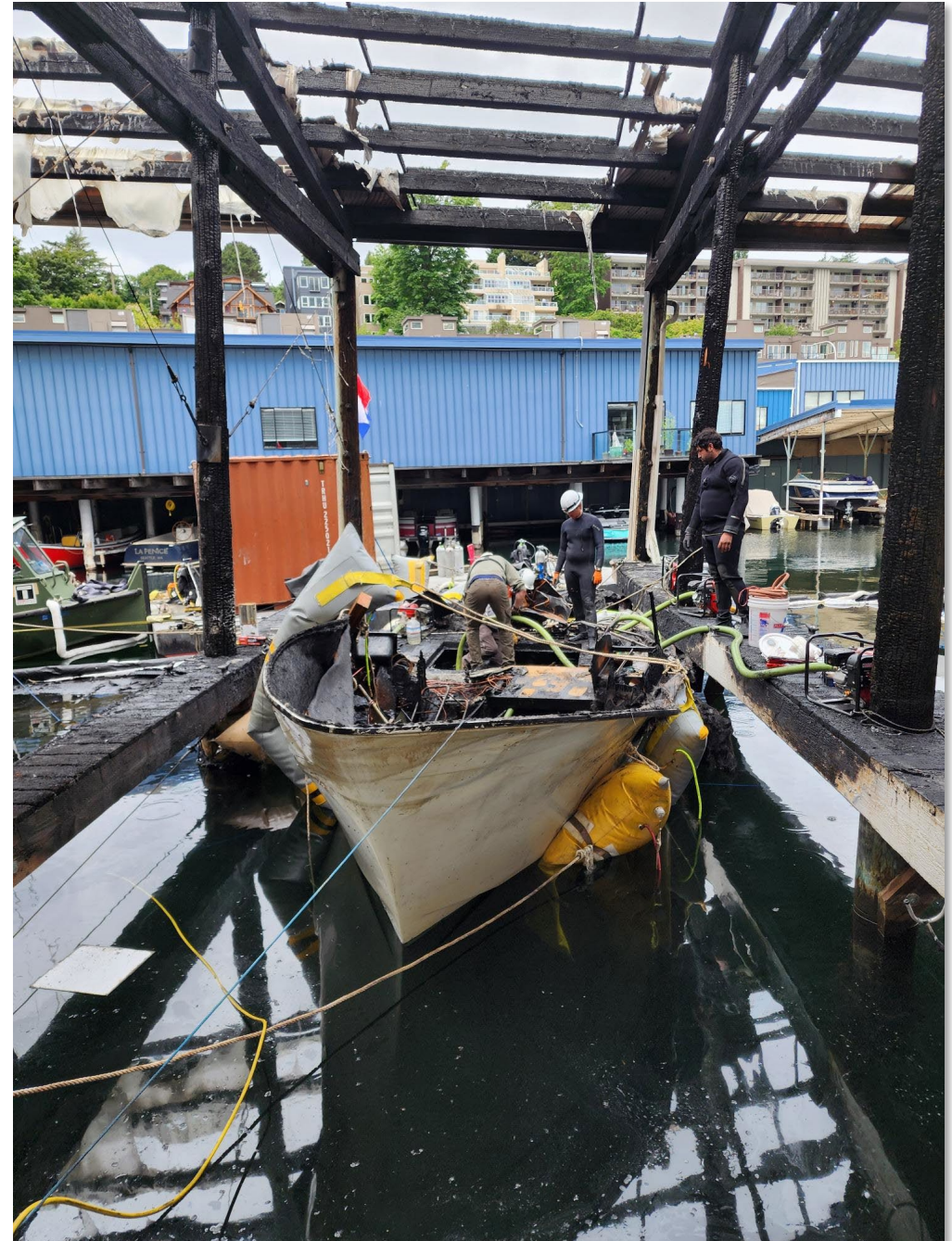

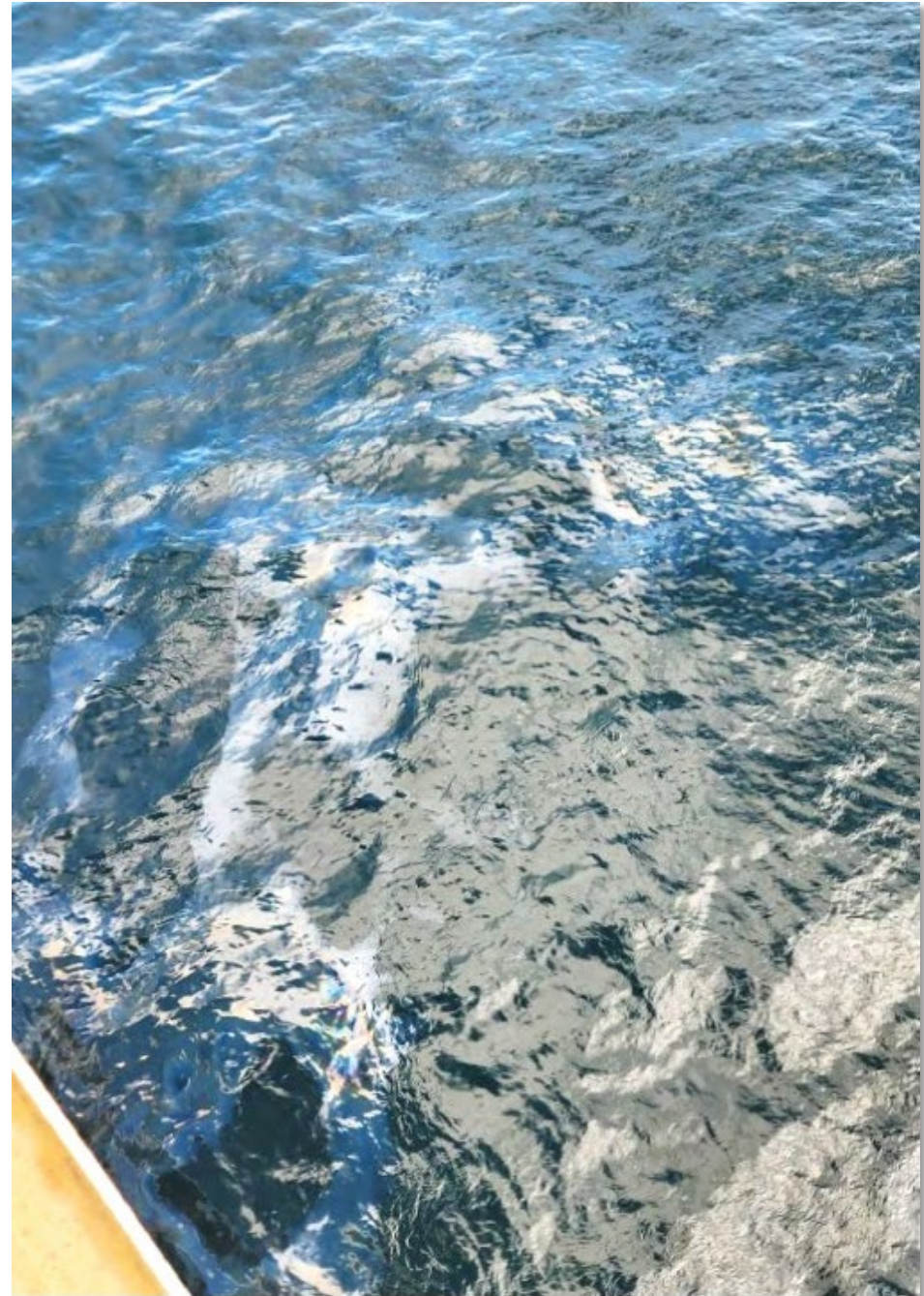
MV Liberty Peace, waste oil spill, off Manchester, September 29,
2023

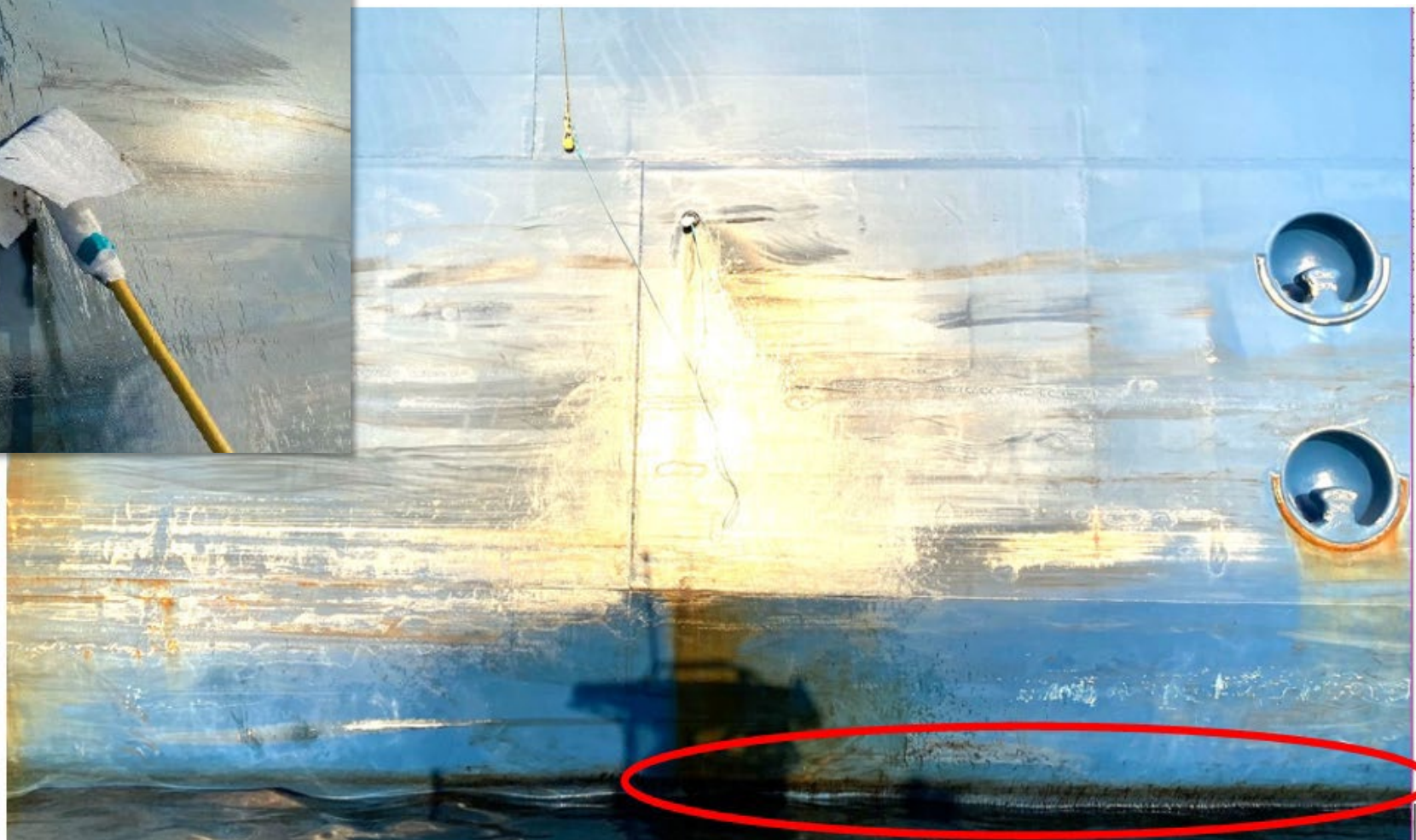
