

## PREASSESSMENT SCREENING OIL SPILL REPORT FORM

**Date of Incident:** December 3, 2020

**Potential Liable Party:** United States Army Corps of Engineers

**Product Spilled:** Turbine Oil

**Spill Source:** Power Generation Utility

**Incident Summary:** On December 3, 2020, the United States Army Corps of Engineers reported as much as 200 gallons of turbine oil spill from their #2 thrust hub cooler unit into the Columbia River. The spilled oil entered the fish unit on the west side of the power plant. The Army Corps isolated the unit, and deployed booms, absorbents and a skimmer into the river. Oil sheen was observed as far south as the Dalles Bridge. None of the spilled oil was recovered within the initial 24 hours.
