

## PREASSESSMENT SCREENING OIL SPILL REPORT FORM

**Incident Summary:** The 42' powerboat P/C TONIC, with an estimated 200 gal of diesel and 35' sailboat P/C PURSUIT with an estimated 30 gal of diesel both caught fire and sank at Foss Harbor Marina around 0230. Tacoma FD responded by deploying hard boom and fighting the fire with firefighting foam. TONIC sank and continued to slowly release diesel and Ecology responders placed sweep in the slip. Global Diving and Salvage were hired to defuel and raise the vessels. However, the diver determined that the badly damaged TONIC was unable to be defueled and that, as it sank, it came to rest on top of the PURSUIT, blocking any access to a fuel port. Both vessels were removed the next day (2/12) with a Quigg Bros crane and barge. The total volume of oil spilled is under investigation.
