**Incident Summary:** On July 10, 2022, the Cascade Water Alliance reported a spill of 80 gallons of vegetable oil to the waterway near their facility at the Barkubein Basin in Buckley, WA. The spill was caused by a blown hydraulic line in the pump house. The spill was mostly contained to a 200-300 square foot area against a wooded area near the pump house. Ecology placed sorbent booms across the channel downstream of the spill. Cascade hired US Ecology to cleanup the spill. An estimated 36 gallons of oil was recovered within the first 24-hours of the spill.
