**Incident Summary:** Two recreational vessels were damaged during a boat house fire at Clover Island Marina. The fire is believed to have started in boat house #5 due to unknown causes and spread to #4, although the cause of the fire is still under investigation at this time. The owner of the vessel in #5 reported that the vessel contained approximately 100 gallons of gasoline. This vessel burned and sank and has yet to be recovered. The vessel in boat house #4 was on a lift and contained a reported 75 gallons of gasoline, most of which is believed to have burned off. Containment boom was initially placed by the local Fire Department and was handed off to Clean Harbors to maintain. Ecology also contracted Clean Harbors for cleanup of the spill and burned boat houses.
