**Incident Summary:** On September 23, 2023, Ecology responded a 30-gallon gasoline spill

from the F/V SULTAN on Salmon Bay in the Lake Washington Ship Canal. The spill came from a break in the seam of a 55-gallon drum stored on its stern deck, port side. Ecology and USCG responders isolated the drum and repositioned it to stop the leak. Responders also deployed sorbent pads to the deck and scuppers to prevent remaining fuel from flowing overboard. Ecology responders estimate that about 25 gallons of gasoline made it overboard. The vessel owner has made plans to transfer the remaining gasoline (about 25 gallons) into a secure container for

appropriate disposal.
