Incident Summary: On July 24, 2024, a Swanson's Bark Semitruck driver had a medical issue

and struck Thunder BAL Distributors LLC Semitruck head-on and ruptured its fuel tank, spilling approximately 200 gallons of diesel to pavement on the Lewis and Clark Bridge in Longview. The fuel flowed down the gutter line and into the Columbia River at the Port of Longview small boat dock. Oregon Department of Transportation hired Republic Services for the cleanup response. The bridge deck and port area were swept, the small boat dock was cleaned, and both hard and sorbent boom

were placed in the impacted area of the Columbia River.
