Incident Summary: On December 5, 2024, the 22-foot Tug *Elsie* sank at its moorage at the

Shipyard Cove Marina in Friday Harbor, San Juan Island. A yet-to-be-determined volume of diesel fuel spilled to the marina. The vessel owner, IOSA and the Port of San Juan Island deployed containment boom and sorbents around the vessel. By the time Ecology Responders arrived on scene, the vessel owners had used a nearby crane barge to pull the tug from the water. Responders removed saturated sorbents from the water.
