**Incident Summary:** On August 20, 2025, the Tacoma Fire Department reported the grounded

45-foot P/C *Jeanette* at the Tacoma Yacht Club. Tacoma FD deployed hard containment boom lined by sorbent boom around the vessel. The next high tide submerged the vessel and resulted in the release of red-dye diesel. Ecology responders added more sorbents within the containment boom and the USCG hired Global Diving to remove the fuel. The vessel's owner estimated that the two 800-gallon diesel tanks were each about half full. Global removed approximately 430 gallons of diesel from the vessel and collected two cubic yards of saturated sorbents. Ecology estimates that up to 370-gallons of diesel spilled to Commencement Bay. The P/C *Jeanette* was floated to Breakwater Marina where it currently

remains floating at a marina slip.
