Incident Summary: On the morning of January 12, 2023, the driver of a private vehicle

hydroplaned and struck the saddle tank of a Washington Compost semitruck on NB I-5, MP 169. An estimated 70 gallons of diesel was released from the semi's tank with an estimated 50 gallons into a storm drain, creating a sheen on Lake Union after it flowed through the drainage system and an outfall operated by WSDOT. Washington Compost service crew members placed and monitored absorbent boom and pads at the

outfall until there was no further observations of sheen.
