RE:	Olympia Bioretention Study III – Site Eligibility Round One Technical Memorandum (R.A.I. No. 2023-002-001)

This memorandum has been prepared to provide a summary of our selection process for identifying bioretention sites eligible for the Olympia Bioretention Study III. A total of 62 potential sites have been nominated for the study. Presently, 24 sites have been identified as eligible for the study, with several of these 24 site owners having provided authorization to use the sites. We are requesting approval from the City of Olympia to begin data collection at the approved sites. The goal is to evaluate a total of 50 sites in the study and additional sites are currently under consideration.

### **IDENTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL SITES**

The Olympia Bioretention Study III is investigating long-term efficacy of bioretention sites in the Puget Sound Basin. Therefore, only sites that have been in operation for at least ten years are considered eligible. Identification of potential sites began with a review of previously evaluated sites from past studies, as well as reaching out to numerous contacts for site recommendations. As stated above, a total of 62 potential sites have been identified to date.

### SITE FIELD EVALUATION

In April 2023, Alex Johanson from AESI began conducting field evaluations to determine study eligibility of each potential site. The field evaluation includes verification that the site is a bioretention facility, as opposed to a grass swale, stormwater detention pond, constructed wetland, noneligible rain garden, or other noneligible

landscape feature. During each field evaluation, data has been collected to count the number of individual bioretention cells, their approximate size, and accessibility of a water source. Photos were taken to document site conditions and an evaluation form was completed for each potential site.

# ASSESSMENT OF SITE ELIGIBILITY

Following field evaluations, each bioretention site has been rated in half point increments on a scale of 0 to 1 in the following categories: 1) water access, 2) site access, 3) vegetation presence, and 4) ponding depth capacity. Sites with a total score of 2.5 or higher have been determined to meet sufficient criteria to be included in the study. At present, 24 eligible sites have been identified (see Attachment 1).

### CONCLUSION

In this initial round of site evaluation, 24 eligible sites have been identified. In consideration of potential time and scheduling constraints, we respectfully submit this initial list and request approval from the City of Olympia and Ecology to begin data collection at these sites. We will submit another list of eligible sites in the future as additional sites continue to be evaluated for study eligibility.
