  - Pressure washing:
    - Unclear message from photo, separate topic, varying regulations among cities
    - Include more BMPs for pressure washing?
- Two additional new outreach items to be developed
  - Survey on new outreach topics
  - Follow-up communications with PPA program and permittees
     Discussion:
    - Identify priority audience(s)
    - Choose topics with little or no regulations + gaps present in existing materials + high concern for stormwater. Examples: landscapers, painters.

- Businesses that are regulated through other programs/agencies at jurisdictions or other permits: construction, FOG, food trucks.
- Businesses with low concern for stormwater: exhaust hood cleaners, pesticide applicator, solid waste haulers
- Other ideas/topics from survey: tile/marble installers, grease/tallow collectors
