TASK 2: Survey of Municipal O&M Programs, 20 minutes

- Review key findings and results from survey (memo deliverable from 9/28/22)
 - o Ponds, trenches, vaults, and tanks
- > Reviewed selected findings from survey:
 - Types of BMPs in use
 - Reasons for maintenance
 - Frequency of maintenance after inspection
- Discussion on what BMPs are included in vaults and tanks

TASK 3: Literature Review of Published BMP Data, 15 minutes

- Summary of literature reviewed
- Database to compare maintenance criteria
- Draft technical memorandum: expected for TAC review in December-January
- Reviewed purpose of task and what literature and data sources were searched
 - Most sources focused on water quality studies
 - Most productive source was Center for Watershed Protection Online Watershed Library
 - Municipal O&M guidance and standards
- > Discussion of other potential sources of maintenance criteria information for proprietary BMPs:
 - Typically for vaults
 - TAPE program
 - Specific proprietary vendors, e.g., Contech, BayFilter, Stormceptor, etc.

- Maintenance procedures by authorized vendors
- Discussion of vegetation maintenance, inspection, and viability
 - how much of an invasive is tolerable
 - what vegetation coverage to target
