Subject: Quarterly update of USGS level logger maintenance

This memo summarizes and documents the level logger download and maintenance work done during the 4th quarter of water year 2020, from July 1 through September 30, 2020.

During this time period, all 33 Puget Small Streams sites were visited during the summer watershed health measurement. All sensors were downloaded except for the water sensor on DesMoines Creek (095WUGA; PSS05515-030323) that was missing. After the data were downloaded, all sensors were redeployed to collect data until the end of the water year, September 30, 2020.
