
STORMWATER WORKGROUP FOR PUGET SOUND

SWG Purpose and Objectives

To support efforts to restore the Puget Sound ecosystem and protect water quality and stream habitat throughout Western Washington.

To sustainably implement SAM – a cooperative, permittee-driven stormwater monitoring and assessment program.

To provide actionable information for stormwater managers about reducing harm caused by stormwater through SAM, convening the SWG, and working collaboratively with partners.

Task 3: Continue to support the SWG 6PPD Subgroup in their efforts to advance the stormwater management of 6PPD, 6PPDguinone, and tire wear particles.

Task 5: Bridge stormwater work with the implementation of the Healthy Environmental for All (HEAL) Act and regional environmental justice initiatives.

Task 6: Update the SWG Charter.

Task 7: Reintegrate the SWG into PSEMP by participating in PSEMP Work Group Lead Meetings.

Task 8: Increase the connection between the general SWG and SWG caucuses.

Task 9: Communicate regularly with stormwater managers, policy makers, and other interested parties.
