


25-27 Biennium Budget

- **\$1.1 million** to conduct monitoring and analyze water and sediment for 6PPD
- \$2.9 million to find safer alternatives to 6PPD in consumer products
- **\$4.4 million** to identify effective best management practices to treat 6PPD in stormwater

\$8.4 million

Finding safer alternatives to 6PPD

- Hazard criteria contains toxicity criteria
- Data on acute aquatic toxicity to:
 - Coho salmon.
 - Rainbow trout.
 - Two other food chain levels.
- Data on transformation toxicity
- If the department finds safer alternatives exist, recommend regulatory, policy, or legislative actions to advance safer alternatives.

- 6PPD
 - Tires
 - Recycled rubber products
- Products report: available now

Alternatives – preliminary results

- CCPD: currently assessing toxicity tests
- 7PPD, IPPD, and durazone-37
 - Have not failed toxicity testing yet
 - Good rubber performance
- Graphene
 - Probably can't remove 6PPD completely from tires





Flexsys – 6PPD Manufacturer

- Only U.S.-based manufacturer
- Contract with USDA synthesizing chemical alternatives
- 3 candidates moving to toxicity testing with USGS
 - No PPDs, non quinone forming
- 12-18 months to share alternative testing results
- Estimate 10 years all passenger tires 6PPD free
- Estimate 15 years all truck tires 6PPD free



Considerations - Alternatives Projects

- Rubber performance testing
- Alternatives toxicity tests: hyalella, daphnia, coho salmon, rainbow trout, mussels
- Additional 6PPDQ species sensitivity testing: invertebrates, lamprey



Considerations - Action Plan Projects

- Defining PPDs as a class
- Other products with 6PPD
- Holistic health effects from salmon decline
- Emerging Contaminants Collaborative
- 6PPD research clearinghouse
- Field monitoring
- Artificial turf alternative and installation guidance

Proposed - Tire Fee in Washington

- Oregon tire fee bill (HB 3362) transportation?
 - 4% tax: stormwater mitigation and rail upgrades
- Potential modifications for WA bill
 - Paid by tire industry
 - \$1....\$3.....\$5....sunsets for 6PPD free tires
 - Certification process for 6PPD free tires
 - Stormwater mitigation and safer alternatives
