

Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF)	\$114.5 million
Clean Water Act Section 319 Grant Program (Section 319)	\$1.9 million
Stormwater Financial Assistance Program (SFAP)	\$35 million
Sewer Overflow and Stormwater Reuse Municipal Grants Program (OSG)	\$746,000
Stormwater Community-Based Public-Private Partnership Program (CBP3)	\$2.2 million
Municipal Stormwater Grants of Regional or Statewide Significance (GROSS)	\$930,000

The funding levels on the draft list are estimates and may change. If final funding for any of the programs is less than the amounts estimated, we will re-evaluate the number of projects and the amount of funding for each project we can support. Public comments and possible changes may affect the proposed funding amounts and projects.


- Includes detailed information about the funding sources, process and the CWSRF key conditions.

- Includes offer amounts and project descriptions.
- Can filter by project category, hardship, and location.








Construction Stormwater General Permit Draft Anticipated Schedule

 - November 19, 2025


• Effective: January 1, 2025

- Sites under an acre




