- * as amended by the “Build Act” of 2018*


TRIBAL TAB TEAM

Tribal Technical Assistance to Brownfields (TAB)


- ❖ *a National Program*

TAB Assistance & Training to Nations/Tribes

- Free assistance to the Tribal Response Program (TRP) brownfields efforts
 - Coordinated through the tribal TRP-Brownfields coordinator or Environmental Program Manager.
- Requests for assistance accepted on a 'first come' basis
 - Depends on KSU TAB staff/funding availability
- No application process, just contact us

TAB Assistance & Training to Nations/Tribes: Topics



- Assist with the 4 TRP Elements and the Public Record
- Assist with Institutional Controls and other site controls and issues
- Tailored to specific tribal & community needs and cultural traditions

TAB Assistance & Training May Include:

- Establishing a new TRP-Brownfields Program
- Assisting with Enhancing a TRP-Brownfields Program
- Assisting with the TRP 4 Program Elements
 - Help identifying and inventorying brownfields
 - Ensuring Response Actions are conducted and Adequate
 - Community outreach, input & workshops
 - Verification and certification of Response Actions

- *Review of EPA 104(k) competitive brownfield grant applications*




