



Advisory Committee Timeline & Deliverables



Deliverable #1: Workload Analysis

- Asses the staffing level necessary in the WQ permit fee program to support adequate levels of service to permittees
- Includes: FTE level & corresponding revenue level

Deliverable #2: Fee Schedule Recommendation

Recommend a fee structure for the program to reduce municipal wastewater permit backlogs and recover the cost of administering the permits.

Deliverable #3: Communication Materials (optional)


Collaboratively create materials for consistent messaging and necessary background to explain the fee increase to stakeholders.





Current communication workplan includes:


- Our overall goals/what we're trying to accomplish



2023


July-August email update on the final status of the fee rule and permit staff budget request, and updates on staffing and backlog rates.
