

What is a groundwater subarea?

RCW 90.44.130

"the department shall have authority... to designate groundwater areas or subareas, to designate separate depth zones within any such area or subarea, or to modify the boundaries of such existing area, or subarea, or zones to the end that the withdrawals therefrom may be administratively controlled..."


"Each such subarea may be so designated as to enclose all or any part of a distinct body of public groundwater, as the department deems will most effectively accomplish the purposes of this chapter."

Big Picture: Columbia Basin Project Irrigation

- Columbia Basin Act early 1940s
- Return flows commingled with natural groundwater
- State withdrew groundwater in coordination with Reclamation, 508-14 WAC








Pasco Basin Management Area

Pasco Basin History: 2021 Legislative Amendment




Allocation through agreement of groundwater resulting from Columbia Basin Project

Signed in June 2022



Boundary Designation


- Designate external subarea boundary under RCW 90.44.130
- Process: public notices, Ecology findings, SEPA, and final Order
- Boundary defined by Order, management details will be in rule (WAC 173-135)
- Order issued May 9, 2025. It's official...again!

Pasco Basin Rulemaking Chapter 173-135 WAC

RCW 89.12.170 directs Ecology to adopt a rule to implement the comanagement agreement.

Rulemaking will result in a <u>new</u> rule Chapter 173-135 WAC and <u>repeal</u> of older interim rule Chapter 508-14 WAC.

Includes review under State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA)
