Re: Review of WRIA 9 Final Draft Watershed Restoration and Enhancement Plan

Thank you for all of your hard work over the last two years to develop the WRIA 9 Watershed Restoration and Enhancement Plan (watershed plan). At our WRIA 9 Committee meeting on November 16, we reached interim agreement on the final draft watershed plan. We are distributing the final draft watershed plan for entities to complete their review based on the process and schedule provided to the chair. It is at the discretion of each entity to determine their local review process.

The watershed plan, appendices, and associated materials are available on the <u>WRIA 9 Committee's website</u>. In addition, the website includes links the WRIA 9 Committee Overview handout and a template presentation to support your review.

The WRIA 9 Committee will meet on February 23, 2021 at 12:30 p.m. via WebEx to vote on final plan approval. RCW 90.94 (3) states that "... all members of a watershed restoration and enhancement committee must approve the plan prior to adoption." Per the Operating Principles, Committee representatives, with the exception of cities caucus members, must be present at the meeting to provide their vote on behalf of their entity. Cities caucus members (Black Diamond, Normandy Park, and Tukwila) may provide their vote directly to the chair, through the cities caucus representative, or in person at the meeting. The plan will not be submitted to Ecology for review, net ecological benefit determination, or consideration for adoption until all Committee representatives have approved the plan.
