<b>Consumptive Use Estimate</b>	<p>Voted on in April 2020 Consumptive Use Estimate of <b>0.38 cfs / 277.4 AFY</b></p>
<b>Offset Target</b>	<p>Same as Consumptive Use Estimate</p>
<b>Projects</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Several potential water rights acquisitions have been identified by committee members, potentially totaling <b>1.58 cfs</b></li> <li>• Washington Water Trust is assessing other potential water right acquisitions</li> <li>• HDR team is developing detailed descriptions for 6 projects:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Swan Creek</li> <li>• Alward Road</li> <li>• Jovita Creek</li> <li>• Enumclaw Golf Course Stream Restoration</li> <li>• Greenwater Phase 4</li> <li>• West Fork Floodplain Project</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>Policy and Regulatory Recommendations</b>	<p>The Committee is currently discussing the following recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outline the process for purchasing water rights and identify barriers</li> <li>• Review fees for permit-exempt and non-permit-exempt wells for equity/balance</li> <li>• Voluntary metering</li> <li>• Establish incentive programs for water conservation</li> <li>• Update the Ecology Well Log Database</li> <li>• Enhance enforcement by State staff of existing and proposed regulations</li> <li>• Use a centralized database for tracking project implementation</li> <li>• Build structure for plan implementation to support adaptive management</li> </ul>
