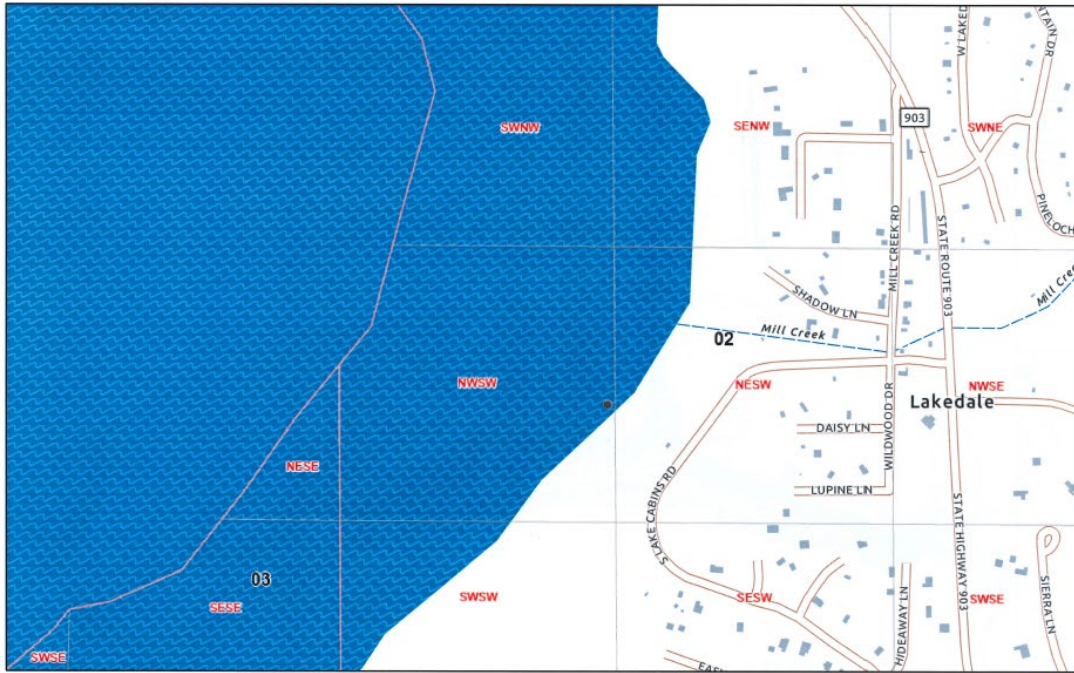

<p>NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:</p> <p>Cle Elum Pool Raise project - The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) is providing an additional 14,600 ac-ft of water to be used for instream flow by raising the elevation of Cle Elum Reservoir by three feet. This creates a need to provide shoreline protection surrounding the reservoir. A temporary water right permit for dust abatement is required during the construction phase of the project.</p> <p>This diversion will be mitigated with Ad. Cert. # S4-83626-J (CS4-01444CTCLsb7).</p> <p>For the dust abatement use, Reclamation will withdraw a maximum of 0.084 cfs (37.5 gallons per minute (gpm)) of water from the Cle Elum Reservoir. The contractor will be required to keep a load count of gallons of water used on the construction project and report the total water used to the Department of Ecology. A pump intake hose will be set by the contractor in the reservoir and used to fill a water truck for use on the construction site for dust mitigation and compaction. Water will be applied to the construction site by spraying it from the truck.</p>

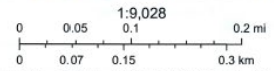
