
Clear Creek Dam Fish Passage Project - The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation is constructing a fish passage system at Clear Creek Dam. The proposed fish passage system will replace a non-functioning ladder on the spillway constructed in 1993. The temporary water right permit for dust abatement is required during the construction phase of the project.

This water use will be mitigated with Ad. Cert. # S4-83626-J (CS4-01444CTCLsb7).

The pumps will be sized to ensure the total maximum diversion rate of 160 gpm of water to fill up to two 3,000-gallon tank trucks filled three times a day, for up to 250 workdays per year, for three years, and will spray the dust abatement water.


