# **Purpose of Use**

Irrigation of 38.2 acres

# **Period of Use**

April 15 through October 1

# **Point of Diversion**

200 feet south and 200 feet east of the north quarter corner of Section 14, being within the NW¼NE¼ of Section 14, T. 19 N., R. 16 E.W.M.

# Place of Use

That portion of the NE¼ of Section 14, T. 19 N., R. 16 E.W.M. lying between the railroad and the Yakima River.

# **Provisions and Limitations of Use**

The instantaneous quantity under both the 1884 and 1894 rights to Yakima River water is limited to no more than 3.35 cubic feet per second.

The right to the use of a water right established under the laws of the State of Washington and confirmed hereby is restricted to the lands or place of use, purpose(s) of use, and to the other specified terms and conditions herein described, unless approved for change as provided in RCW 90.03.380 or other statute.

This certificated water right may be subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in Chapter 90.14 RCW.
