NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The project is located about 10 miles Southeast of Ellensburg, between highway 82 and the Boylston mountains.

While the applicant is eligible for 1040.5 ac-ft/yr under the cost sharing program, they are only requesting 425 ac-ft/yr. The applicant proposes to offset the 425 ac-ft/yr of use for the project with 425 ac-ft/yr of mitigation from the Selah-Moxee Irrigation district.

The Blackhawk well was previously approved in the 2023 drought authorization. All other wells were approved in drought authorizations from 2023 and 2019. Review of the local area hydrogeology suggests that the Wanapum Aquifer, which the wells pull from, is not in overdraft condition and that nearby users will not be impaired by the project.
