NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The project is located approximately 10 miles Northwest of Sunnyside.

The applicant is applying to use 64.6 ac-ft/yr of water, which is their full quantity eligible under the drought cost sharing program. The applicant has provided a draft water mitigation certificate from the Selah-Moxee Irrigation District in the quantity of 64.6 ac-ft/yr.

The existing well, ABI 870, was previously approved in drought authorizations from 2015, 2005, and 2001. Review of the local area hydrology suggests that the Ellensburg Formation, which the well pulls from, is not in overdraft condition and that nearby users will not be impaired by this project.
