## NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Roza is leasing up to 284 ac-ft of consumptive use of water from Mack Creek Ranch, LLC. This is one of the more senior rights on the Teanaway River. The water will be used throughout the irrigation season consistent with the trust water rights schedule to offset Roza's use. This lease will use water that is held in the Trust Water Rights Program for instream flow and mitigation of agricultural uses in the Yakima Basin. This water right associated with this Trust Water Right Agreement is very senior but to the extent that there are any late season water issues in the Teanaway, that cause this this right to be curtailed, Roza will stop using this water immediately. Roza will work closely with Ecology's Water Master to ensure compliance with flows on the Teanaway.

There will be no impact to TWSA.
